SYNOPSIS

```
debugapp [--find] [--gdb=...] application [arguments...]
```

DESCRIPTION

debugapp is a tool that helps you start or find applications by name in debugging mode. It acts as a wrapper around **openapp**, and calls openapp with the --**debug** option. By default gdb is used as the debugger, but this can be changed with the --**gdb**= option or through the **GDB** environment variable.

The *arguments* are the arguments passed to the application.
